

## Goldfields – Cookies Policy

### 1. INTRODUCTION

This document sets out the Cookies Policy ('**Policy**') of Goldfields Group Holdings Pty Ltd (ABN 73 626 532 232) and our related and associated companies and trusts (referred to in this cookies policy as 'Goldfields', 'we', 'us', or 'our').

This Cookies Policy applies to your use of our website, accessible at [Goldfields Property Development](#) ('**Website**'), and explains the types of cookies we use, how we use them, and the ways in which you can manage or control them.

We may update this Policy from time to time by posting a revised version on our Website. We encourage you to review our website periodically to ensure that you are informed of the most current version of the Policy.

### 2. WHAT ARE COOKIES

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information, which your computer or mobile device downloads when you visit a website. Each cookie contains information about your visit to the website, such as the pages you've visited. The next time you visit the site, the cookie will tell the site that you've been here before. Cookies are commonly used on the internet and do not harm your computer in any way.

### 3. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

We may use several different cookies on our Website. These are used for the purposes of website functionality, performance, advertising, and social media or content cookies.

Cookies enhance your experience on our Website, as it allows us to recognise you, remember your details and preferences (for example, your log-in details), and provide us with information on when you've visited and how you've interacted with our Website.

The below table sets out the type of cookies we may collect on our Website.

Strictly Necessary Cookies	Certain cookies are essential to the proper functioning of our Website. Without these cookies, the Website may not operate correctly, and some features may be unavailable to you. For example, such cookies enable the Website to remember information you have entered as you navigate between pages during a single browsing session.
Performance Cookies	Performance cookies collect information about your use of the Website to assist us in improving the services we provide. These cookies gather data on how you interact with the Website, such as the pages you visit and the frequency of your visits. This information enables us to identify usage patterns, collect analytics data, detect technical issues, enhance your browsing experience, and assess the effectiveness and relevance of our marketing activities.
Functional Cookies	Functional cookies enhance your experience on our Website by making it more convenient and personalised. These cookies remember your preferences and details, such as login credentials or regional settings, to tailor your experience accordingly.  Security cookies, a subset of functional cookies, assist in maintaining the security of both the Website and user accounts. Load balancing session cookies operate for the duration of a

	browsing session to distribute network traffic across multiple servers, thereby optimising website performance and capacity. We may also use persistent user interface customisation cookies to store your preferred version of the Website, including font and language preferences.
Advertising cookies	Advertising cookies are used to deliver targeted marketing materials that align with your interests and preferences. These cookies record that you have visited our Website and may share limited, non-identifiable information with third parties. Although these cookies generally do not personally identify you, they enable us to ensure that the advertisements you see are relevant to your interests.
Content cookies	Content cookies are set by social media plugins (such as those allowing content sharing on platforms like Facebook) and other tools that enhance on-site content (for example, services enabling the playback of video files). We integrate these plugins to improve usability and user experience. Some third-party services associated with these cookies may also use them for behavioural advertising or market analysis purposes.

#### 4. HOW LONG WILL COOKIES REMAIN ON MY DEVICE?

The duration for which a cookie remains on your computer or device depends on its type—either a “persistent” or a “session” cookie. Persistent cookies remain on your device until their set expiry date or until you delete them manually, which may range from several minutes to several years. Session cookies, on the other hand, are temporary and are deleted once you close your browser or end your browsing session.

#### 5. HOW DO THIRD PARTIES USE COOKIES ON THE WEBSITE?

#### 6. HOW DO I CONTROL COOKIES?

- (a) In most cases, you can manage or control cookies through your internet browser settings. This includes determining whether your browser accepts cookies, how cookies are stored and managed, and how to delete them at the end of a browsing session.
- (b) Please note that removing or blocking cookies may adversely affect your experience on our Website, and certain features or sections of the Website may become inaccessible.
- (c) Many third-party advertising services provide options to opt out of their tracking systems, often by presenting an opt-out notice or pop-up before cookies are downloaded to your device.
